is a widget You can expand it to make it a full width or have them stacked side by side.

An option here to rename the widget to make it relevant to you Embed the widget and delete.

it from your view For example, I can delete the getting started, which is a helpful guide.

to get things rolling, and it's gone I can always access what I've deleted by clicking.

on the widget, and from here you have an option for getting started So I can just drag it.

and put it back That's it, as easy as that From the top, you have an option here to manage.

your dashboards Obviously, this is probably not the best naming, so I'm going to click.

my dashboards and I'll see it right in here I only have one, so it is by default the one.

that's going to load I can edit it to rename it if I like This could be main reports.

You can also name it by company employees, for example, you can have different people focusing on different reports, or you can break it down by organization like the sales reports, the lead gen and paid ad reports, etc Furthermore, what you can do here is.

create fresh dashboards so you can have reports added On the right side, you can make copies.

of dashboards This is helpful if you're managing multiple assets and domains and such, and.

you'd like to just make copies of your main report Attach them to campaign assets, which.

is a powerful functionality in VBout that lets you group all your content in one place.
